Back by popular demand, Jake Ehrenreich brings his hit musical comedy ***A Jew Grows in Brooklyn*** (January 24, 25, 26) to Aventura. Delving into his struggles with family, Ehrenreich takes the audience on a hilarious romp from the streets of Brooklyn to summers in the Catskills.
