FILM, DANCE IN THE SPOTLIGHT THIS MAY AT AVENTURA ARTS & CULTURAL CENTER

AVENTURA, Fla. – Foreign film and dance are in the spotlight in May at the Aventura Arts & Cultural Center, where the entertainment lineup features a Golden Globe-nominated film and a powerful dance performance to conclude the Arts Ballet Theatre of Florida's season.

The film is not rated and presented in French with English subtitles. Host Shelly Isaacs will introduce the film and lead a post-screening discussion. **Tickets are \$11.**

Student talent is on display when the **Diamond Minds School of the Arts** presents its **2017 Spring Recital** on **Saturday, May 7 at 4 p.m.** The recital showcases the school's talented students through dance, music, and poetry. Everyone, including infants, must have a ticket to enter. **Tickets are \$12; free lap tickets are available at the box office for children 24 months and under.**

The month wraps up when **Arts Ballet Theatre of Florida** presents its **Spring Ballet Gala** on **Saturday, May 13 at 7 p.m.** Under the direction of Ballet Master Vladimir Issaev, Arts Ballet Theatre of Florida ends its season with a repertoire that includes the most famous classical Pas de Deux and neo-classical pieces by Issaev and guest choreographers and international dancers. **Tickets are \$30.**
